Data privacy statement

Data protection

We take the protection of your personal data very seriously. We are committed to keeping your personal data safe and secure and handle your information in accordance with our legal obligations and this data privacy statement.

You can visit this website without disclosing personal details. If personal information (such as your name or your postal or email address) is collected, this will be done on a voluntary basis wherever possible. Your information will not be passed on to any third party without your express permission.

We would like to stress that Internet data transmission (e.g. in email communications) can be subject to security breaches. Complete protection of data from third-party access is not possible.

Cookies

This website uses so-called cookies. These will not cause any damage to your computer and they do not contain any viruses. Cookies help to make our website more user-friendly, effective and secure. They are small text files that will be stored on your computer and in your browser. Most of the cookies we use are so-called session cookies. This means that they will be automatically deleted once you have left our site and closed your browser. Other cookies will remain on your computer until you delete them. These will allow us to recognise your browser on your next visit to our site.

Depending on your browser settings, you will be able to see what cookies have been set. You can choose to accept only certain cookies or accept cookies only in certain cases, you can block all cookies or you can ensure that all cookies are automatically deleted when you close your browser. Disabling cookies can limit the functionality of this website.

Server log files

Our service provider will collect and automatically store information in so-called server log files, which your browser will transmit to us automatically. These include the following information:

Type and version of your browser

Operating system used

Referrer URL

Host name of the computer

Date and time of the server access

This data does not allow us to identify any specific users. It will not be combined with any other data sources. However, we reserve the right to check the data if we have any specific information relating to potentially unlawful acts.

Google Analytics

This website uses certain functions of the web analytics service Google Analytics offered by Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA.

Google Analytics uses so-called cookies. These are text files that are stored on your computer and allow us to analyse how you have used our website. The information created by these cookies about your use of our website is usually transmitted to and then stored on a Google server in the US.
